

Novel Writing

A course in creating a novel length work of fiction

Program Purpose

Writing a novel can be an exhilarating experience. It can also be very daunting. This course is designed to lead the participants through the steps which writers take on their journey from the opening sentence to the last page.

Program Objectives

In attending this course, participants will learn to:

- ⌘ Establish an outline of the story they wish to write
- ⌘ Construct plots, characters and settings to suit the story
- ⌘ Choose a narrative style to suit the story
- ⌘ Gain skills in writing dialogue
- ⌘ Gain skills at setting out chapters
- ⌘ Present their work for publication
- ⌘ Gain an appreciation of publishing requirements and opportunities

Who should Attend

This course is designed for anyone who has a story to tell and would like a framework for sharing that story with others.
