

# Writing History

*A course to transform researchers into writers*

## Program Purpose

Many people spend countless hours researching the history of their families or organisations but find a stumbling block when it comes to documenting their discoveries in a form that is useful to others.

This program is designed to assist historians, amateur and professional, make the transition from researcher to writer.

## Program Objectives

In attending this course, participants will learn to:

- ⌘ Establish an outline of the history they wish to write
- ⌘ Identify the key issues the history will address
- ⌘ Identify the target audience for the history
- ⌘ Choose a style of writing to suite their potential readers
- ⌘ Develop skills to turn their research into well constructed prose
- ⌘ Make decisions on presentation and publication

## Who should Attend

This program is designed to meet the need of anyone involved in historical or genealogical research.

Participants are encouraged to bring their own research material to work on during the program.
